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WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!



Important Notes

We will be making a few changes as our year progresses and we hope that you will continue to support us as we do. Please note that beginning lunch day. A fee of \$5.00 will immediately, all students must be at school by 10 am. This will ensure that your child does not miss important scheduled times including breakfast, small group activities, circle time, play and outdoor socialization.

Please do not ask the teachers to change your child into other shoes when it is time to go outside.
