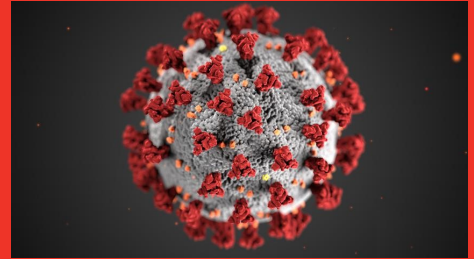


ATTENTION Early Care Programs:

Do you have families who are struggling to pay for child care due to COVID-19?



The **Emergency Voucher Program** is here to help!

What is an Emergency Voucher? A one-time tuition assistance program available to families experiencing crisis situations (loss of employment, change of hours/income, increase in child care costs, health concerns, poverty, divorce, incarceration, fire, flood, etc.).

How do I qualify/apply? Because of these unprecedented times, guidelines are now *flexible and eligibility through membership is being waived. *These funds are temporarily being made available to child care programs regardless of having a Children's Harbor membership. Simply request and complete an application on behalf of a family in need, and we'll do the rest!

What fees might be covered? Child Care Tuition, Monthly CoPays/Surcharges and other tuition related fees.

Funds are limited ~ so, act quickly!
